I love you!

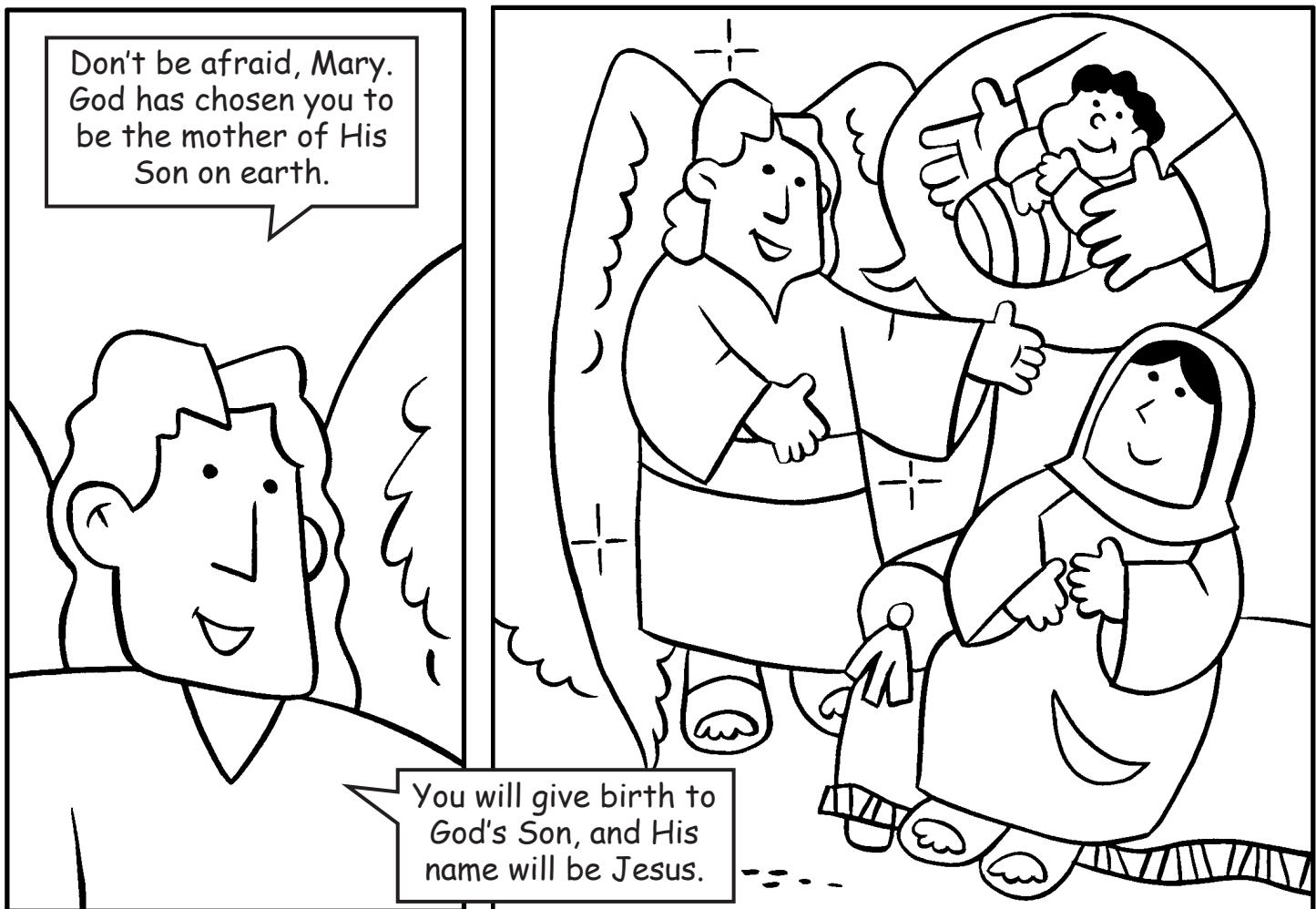
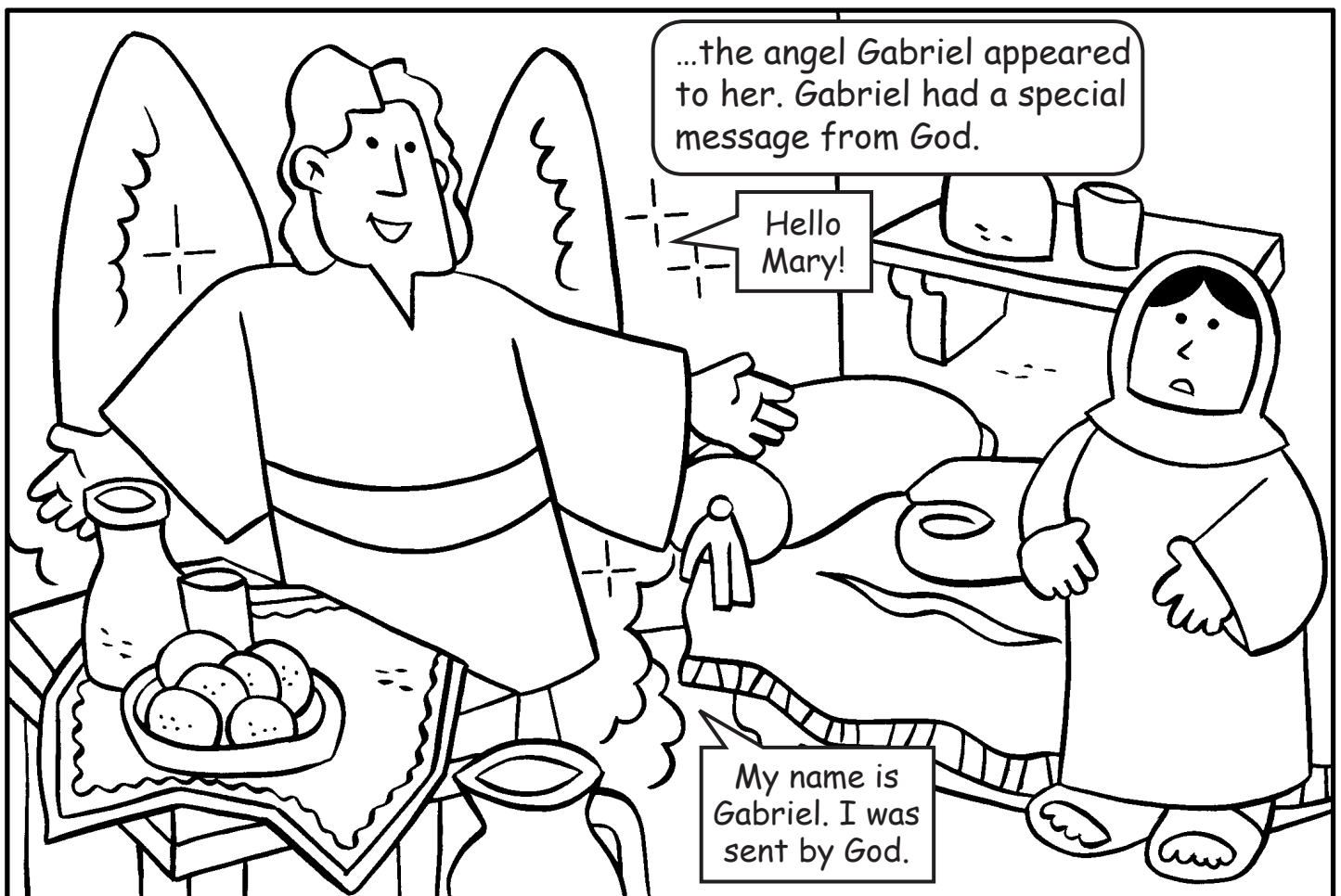
I love you, too!

never end.

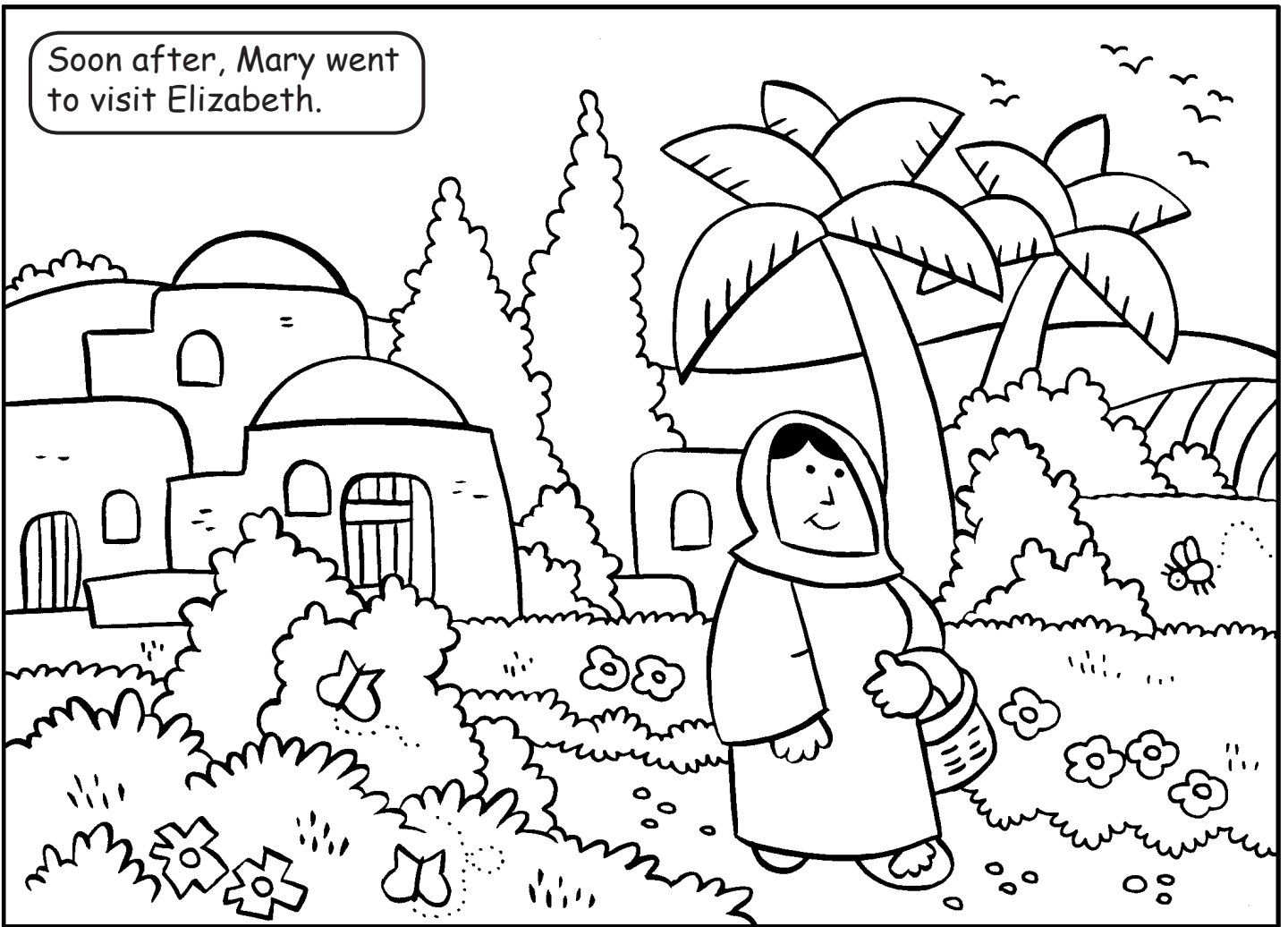
Mary was very

Don't be afraid, Zechariah! God has heard your prayers, and your wife Elizabeth will give you a son. You will name him John.

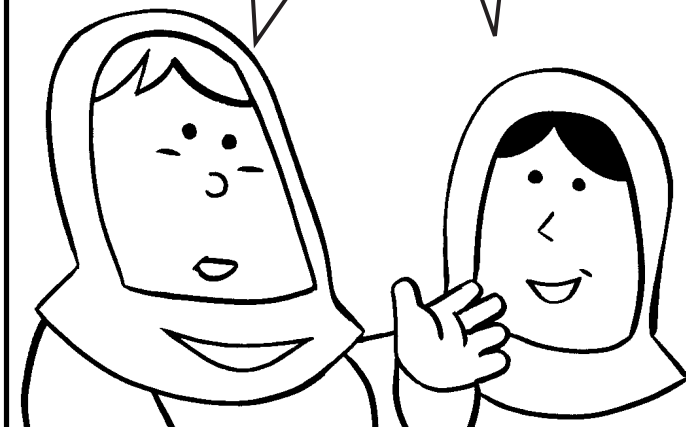
While Zechariah was praying in the temple, suddenly an angel appeared to him.

Believe God's promise! Because you have doubted what I've told you, you won't be able to talk until the baby is born.

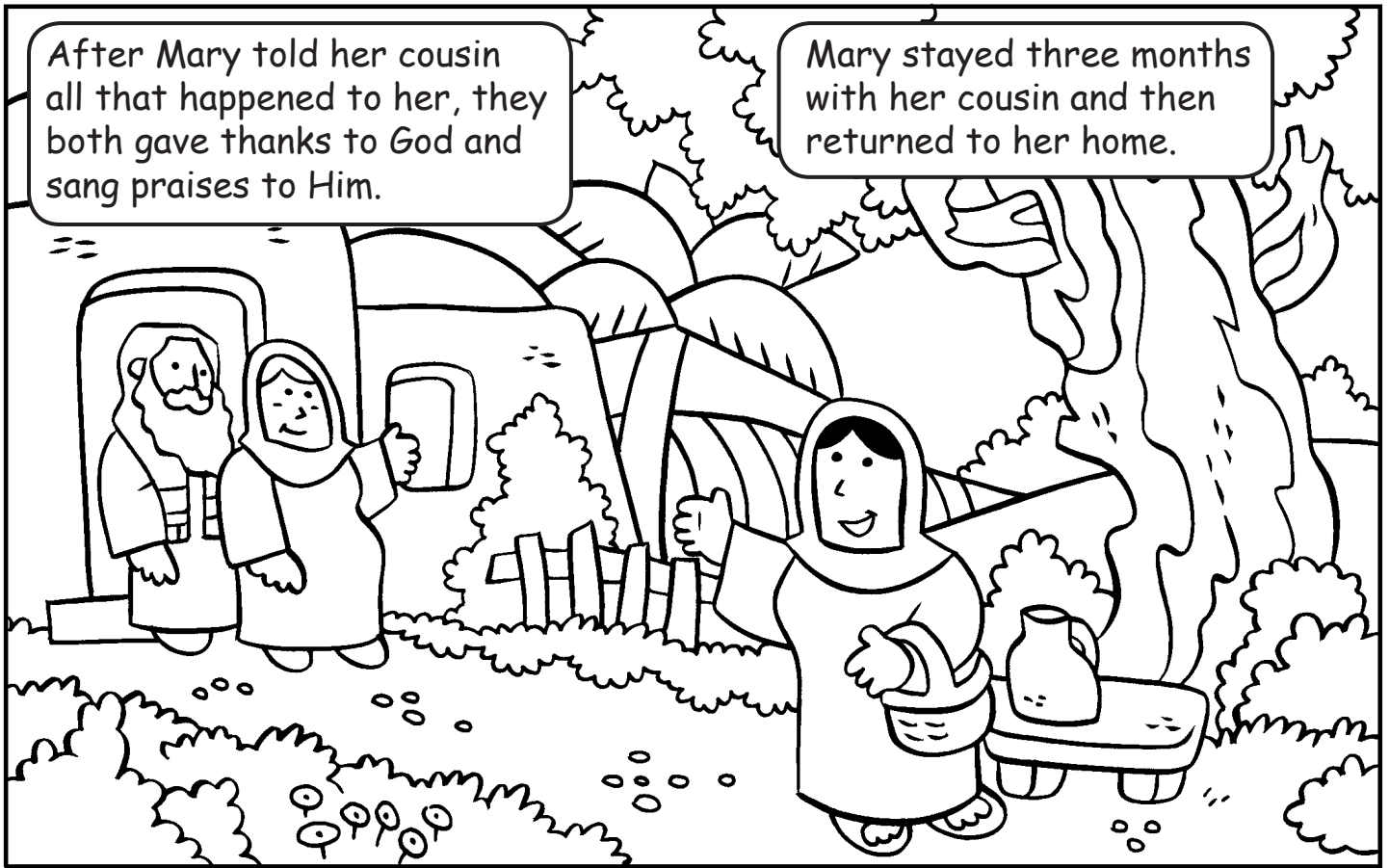
Ever since Zechariah returned home, he has been unable to talk. Instead he writes messages on a tablet.
