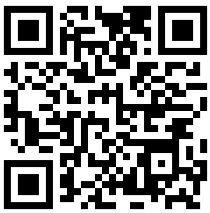

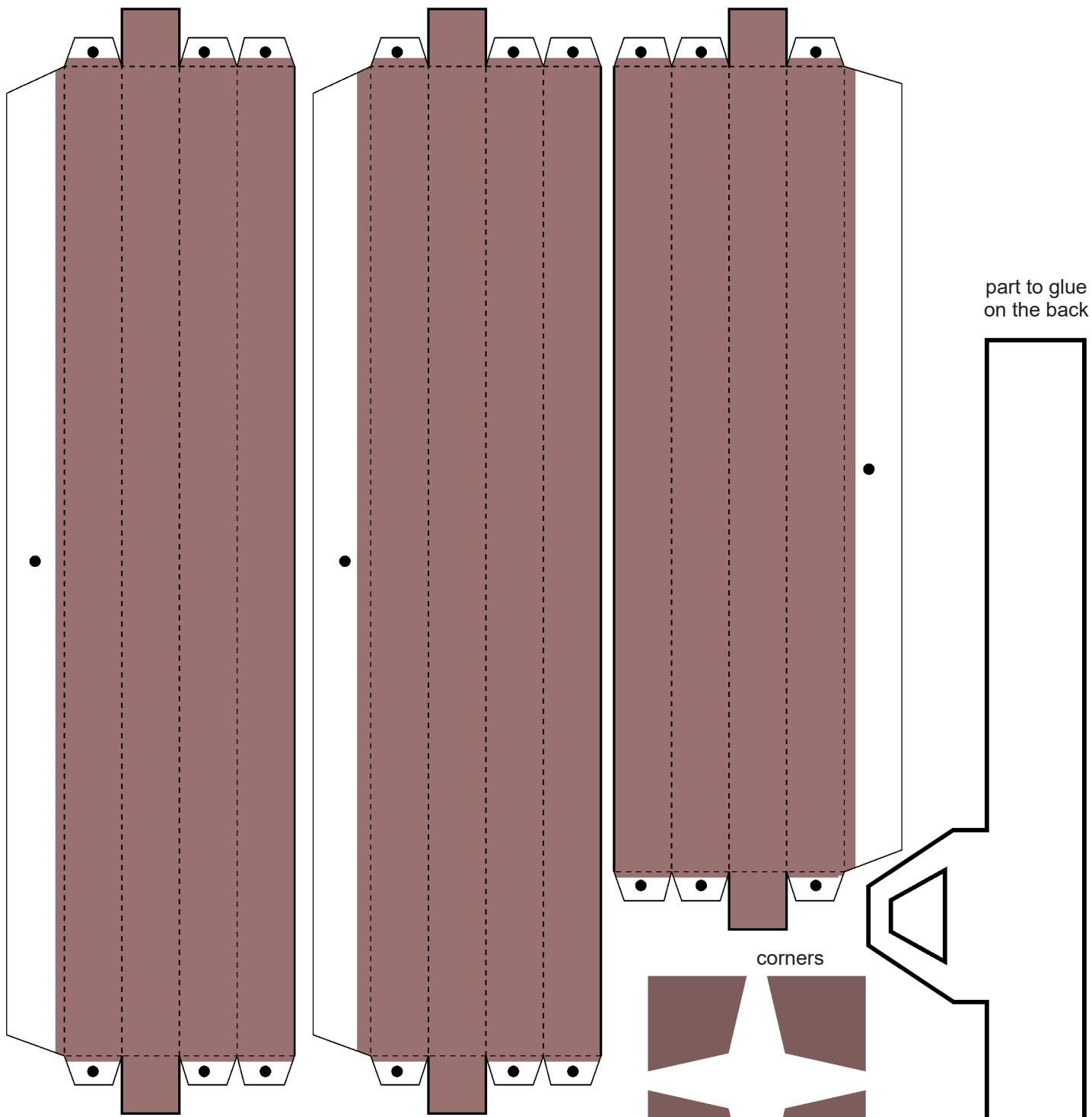

Leather was widely used in Biblical times for sandals and shoes, harnesses for animals, bottles for transporting and storing liquid, and it was also used for parchment.

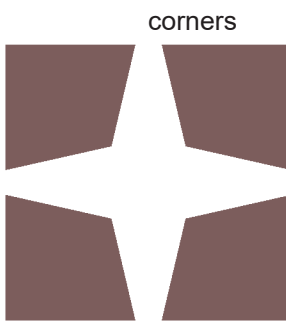
