At that instant, their eyes were opened and they recognized Jesus. Immediately they went back to Jerusalem to tell the good news to the other disciples.

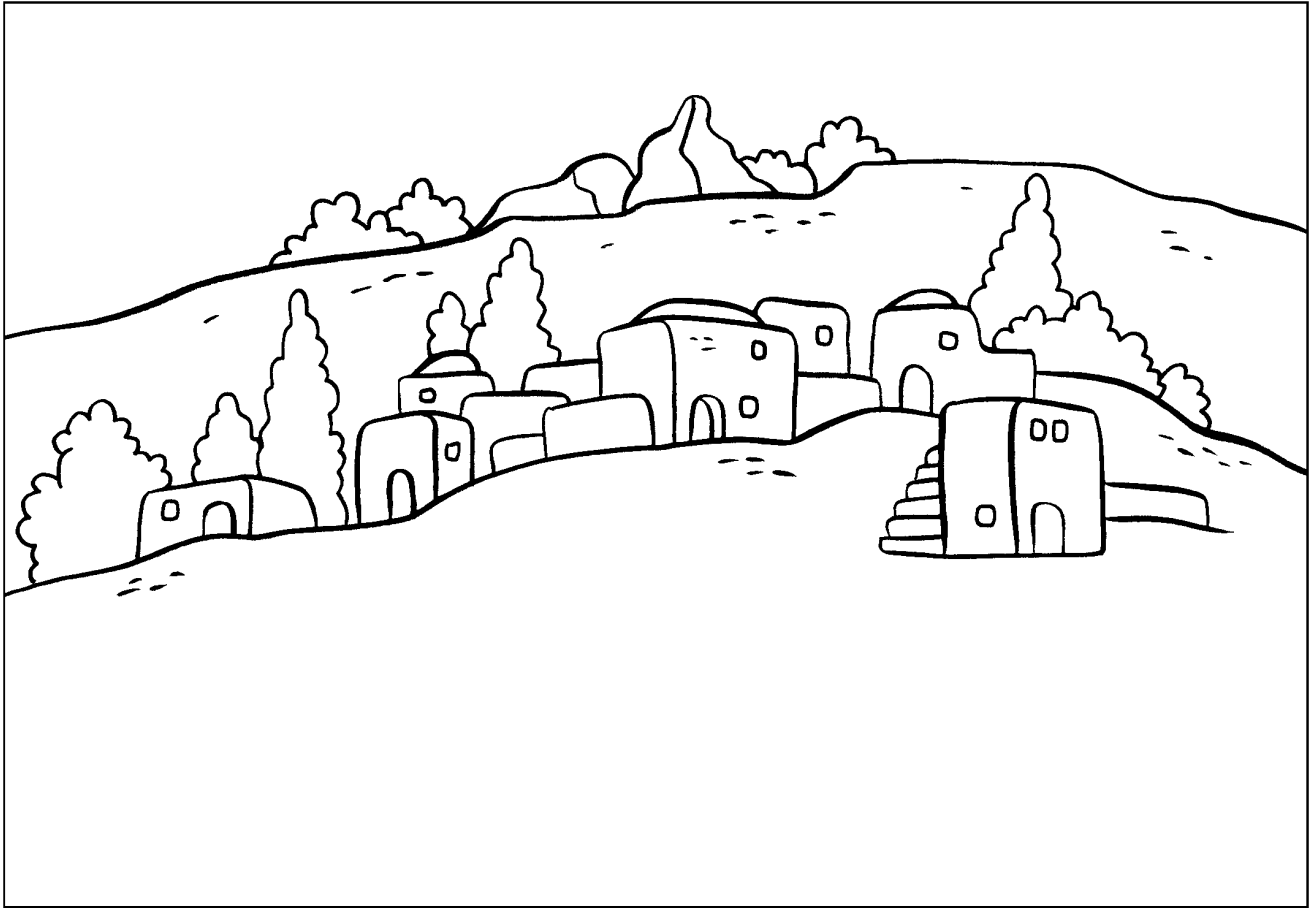
