
One day, some tax collectors and outcasts came to listen to Jesus. The Pharisee started to grumble about them, so Jesus told them this parable:

If any of you had a hundred sheep and one of them was lost, what would you do? You would leave the ninety-nine sheep securely at home and look for the one that got lost.


